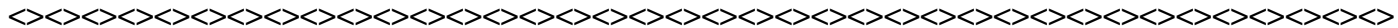

- 2. General Parish Meeting, WEDNESDAY 7 NOVEMBER AT 4:00 PM in the Church:** There were about 10 people at our meeting and much was accomplished. I explained how I wanted to prepare the parish for consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. More about that below. There were several requests that were considered and two of them were accepted. The first was a Rosary once a week after the Daily Mass. The second was more Adoration on a day other than Friday. I have decided to combine these two requests and have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after the 9:00 AM Mass on Wednesdays until 12 Noon. The Rosary will be prayed after the Eucharist is placed on the altar and incensed. I think that the first Wednesday of Advent, 4 December, will be a good date to start.
I am trying NOT to scheduled something on every day of the week, except Mass, because I do have to go to other meetings around the diocese and with the friars, so I would like to combine what we can.
Finally, it was decided that we need to get some information to the parishioners about the financial situation of the parish. We may do this either by information in the newsletter or comments from our Finance Committee at Mass or both.

**CONSECRATION OF ST. ANTHONY PARISH TO THE
IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY**

Technically, we are going to consecrate the parish to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, but because Mary is so closely associated with the mission of her Son, we consecrate ourselves through Mary's Immaculate Heart. **To Jesus through Mary.** Also, since Our Lady of Fatima told us through Sister Lucia that she wanted to establish devotion to her Immaculate Heart, we will be acceding to her request by doing this as a parish and as individuals.

We could simply say a single prayer at some point which would consecrate ourselves and the parish to the Immaculate Heart and that would have some positive, spiritual impact. However, I want this to be a year of prayer, meditation and devotion on the mystery of Mary in God's plan of salvation, so that we can do this with greater awareness and commitment.

We have many important things to do in the near future: increasing the number of persons who attend Mass, finding the lost souls, evangelizing the un-churched and others who are looking for God in all of the wrong places. We need to reach out to young people, children, teens and young adults. We face some financial challenges along with maintaining a beautiful church and garden for the Glory of God and the love of our neighbours. Asking Mary to help us and guide us in our endeavours is essential to our accomplishing the Will of God within our parish.

The year will begin on the weekend 8-9 December, the 8th being the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. We will begin our consecration on the weekend during which we consider the beginning of Mary's life, the dawn of the New Creation. It will end one year later, on the same weekend 7-8 December 2019. Since the 8th is the 2nd Sunday of Advent, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception will be moved to 9 December, but we will say the final prayer of consecration at the weekend Masses.

The program will be based on the feast days of Mary, during the Church Year, especially those which compose the Rosary, the five Marian Dogmas, her major apparitions and prayers to and with Mary. Much of this information will come through the newsletter. On one weekend in the newsletter there will be a reflection on one of Mary's feast days, titles or dogmas. On another there will be a devotion to Mary, some of the familiar ones and some not so well-known. Each month, on the 2nd Wednesday at 11:00 AM in the church there will be a presentation about the Mother of God. We are choosing the mornings knowing that coming to our church after dark, with our parking situation, is difficult for some of our parishioners. In the Spring, when the days get longer and warmer, we will move the time to the evening so that some of our working people will be able to attend. With hope we will find a varied group of presenters. We may change the venue for some months. There will be a few pilgrimages to perhaps Walsingham, Fatima, the Arundel Cathedral in November or other sites.

Once I get more detail to the program, we will publish it, publicize it and make it available on the web site. So, join us as we contemplate the greatness of our God, guided by our Mother Mary!

O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee.
