**TIME TO RETURN TO THE USA:** As I stated in the email that I sent to those parishioners for whom we have emails, every friar knows from the first day he arrives in an assignment that there will be a last day in his assignment. That day is quickly coming upon me as I will be going back to America around 15 September.

People often ask friars if they are happy to leave here and go there. There are positives and negatives to both realities, but the question is irrelevant. The friar finds his only joy in the vow of obedience upon which his life is based. So, as I came here at the request of Fr. James, so I will be returning at the request of Fr. Michael. I am not sure exactly where I will be living, but I will let you know as soon as I can. I will certainly miss all of you and the time we spent walking hand in hand toward Heaven. But there are people in America, from upstate NY to NJ to PA to OH to NC and other places who have missed me for seven years, and we are anxious to once again enjoy our friendships.

I think that we have accomplished many good things in the parish during the last seven years. I hope above all that we have returned to some stability after the tragic events that led to a "pastor-less" parish for a while. I will have more to say in the next newsletter.

My last Sunday here will be 11 September, a day of infamy for my home country, who suffers more from fools nowadays than any other time in our nation's history. I think that I will fly away from England on 15 September, the 77<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of my parents' wedding.

I thank all of you for the spiritual, physical and material support that you have given me over the past seven years, especially during my two hospital visits also those who attended daily Mass.

God bless all of you and your families through the intercession of Ss. Anthony and Walburga!!!
