A Christmas Gift of hope to all mankind

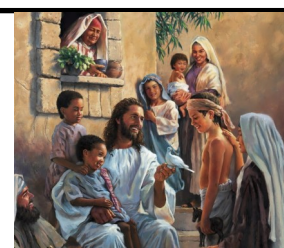
(A beautiful poem written by one of our parishioner's this Christmas, moved by the Holy Spirit)

And calmed the breeze.**

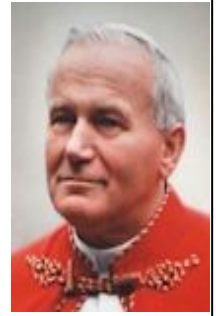

Of those 44% say they have no religion (1996 people) while 48% declare themselves as Christian (2150 people). Our parishioner numbers are currently around 70 people while those who attend St Mary's account for around 120 people. So our question is where are the other 1960 people?

How can we extend the hand of welcome and friendship to those who still feel the strength of Christ in their hearts to proclaim His name but do not feel able to, or called to come together in the hope, joy and community of Mother Church?
