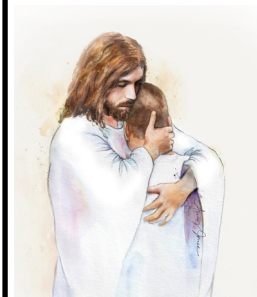
Rye and Tenterden come together for Lenten journey of discovery

For five weeks, starting from Monday 13th February, we will be joining Tenterden in their Parish Hall to share our faith journey and to get to know our Lord and our brother that little bit better through Lent.

Monday 13th , 20th, 27th February and Monday 6th and 13th March, we are invited to join Tenterden at 10.00a.m for Mass, followed by tea and biscuits and then to journey together through the Lenten Sycamore programme. Mass begins at 10.00a.m and the course will from 10.30 a.m to 12.00noon each week.

CAFOD Lenten Appeal



This lent CAFOD have organized an appeal for the people of Ukraine , who have suffered at the hand of aggression for over twelve months now.

Working with and supporting local charities in Ukraine, CAFOD have established food banks in areas of devastation that now serve over 21,000 people a week in various cities . They have supplied over 700 bicycles to volunteers to be able to take these supplies to people on outlying areas. While in the refugee handling centres in Poland, which have received up to 100,000 people a day, CAFOD have supported the refugees with pre-paid cash cards to allow them to pay for food, basic supplies and rent.

The appeal is called “ **The Big Lent Walk**”. It is encouraging those who are able to do so to walk 200km during the 40 days of Lent and to arrange sponsorship while doing it. Do we have anyone interested in taking part? For more info speak to either Simon or Jenny (our CAFOD rep).

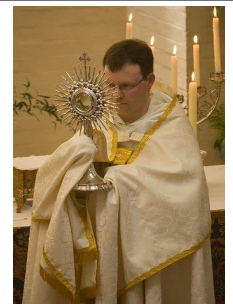
