Believers pray for justice, for peace and for the environment, including The Prayer of St Francis. The Prayer of St Francis is **a prayer for peace**. In a world often troubled by war and violence, it calls us to be instruments of Christ's peace and love

A quote from Pope Francis: "The Way of the Cross alone defeats sin, evil and death, for it leads to the radiant light of Christ's resurrection and opens the horizons of a new and fuller life. It is the way of hope, the way of the future.
